ETHICAL BANKING – Sophie Franklin has provided some information about ethical banking. Briefly this is an opportunity to try to persuade banks to stop loaning money to fossil fuel diggers who are effectively destroying our planet. GIFT AID AND FUNDS - a reminder that if you pay tax your giving to the church is eligible for 25% tax relief eg your donation of £10 is worth £12.50 to the church.

If you are a tax payer but prefer to give a cash donation during the service please make use of the Gift Aid envelopes in the vestibule or in the chairs. Your £5 donation is worth £6.25 to the church.

Please see me if you have not yet completed a Gift Aid form. Also if you have previously completed a form but are no longer a tax payer I need to know to amend my records.

A big thank-you to all those who continue to give what they are able in support of our church and its work. Sadly our overall giving has reduced significantly over the past few years and even with additional income from other sources (Lettings, coffee sales and general fundraising etc) we are not able to meet our financial commitments - hence the drive by the Welcome Space team to increase our income.

Any further suggestions as to how to raise funds are always welcome.

CHAIRS - As you are aware the chairs in church are to be replaced by new ones which will be lighter, easily stacked and moved on trolleys. A sample of the new chair has been in the Church for several weeks now and an order for 80 of the new chairs will be placed in the coming week.
